 Rinse pat dry and slice 1/2 pound fresh mushrooms set aside In large saucepan fry 6 slices bacon until crisp crumble set aside Pour off all but 3 tablespoons bacon fat Add 1 cup diced onions to hot bacon fat saute 5 minutes Stir in 1/4 cup flour. cook 2 minutes Add 3 cups water 1 10-3/4 oz can condensed chicken broth 2 cups peeled diced potatoes 1 cup sliced carrots 2 tablespoons chopped celery leaves 2 tablespoons chopped parsley 1 bay leaf 1/2 teaspoon sage 1/4 teaspoon black pepper Bring to boil Cover reduce heat simmer 20 minutes Add celery and simmer 8 minutes Add reserved mushrooms and simmer 3 minutes longer Stir in milk Heat only until hot Stir in reserved crumbled bacon

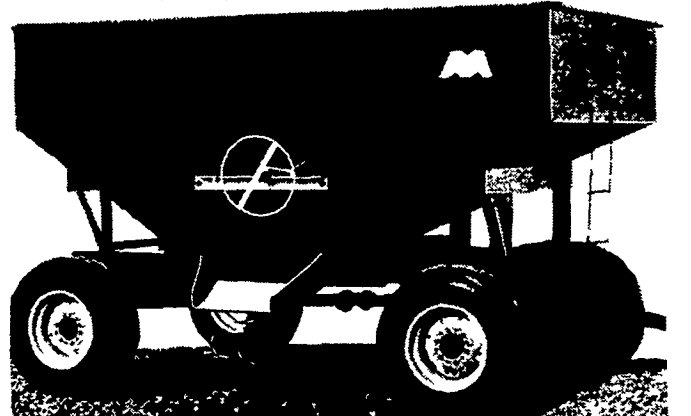
