

# \$7300 top at Sire Power sale

Bidding was brisk and prices competitive at the 1975 Sire Power Sale held July 29 at the Kutztown, Pa.

Fairgrounds 64 head sold for an average of \$1575 in a sale dominated by Elevation and Kingpin progeny.

Topping the sale at \$7300, was a tall stylish Round Oak Rag Apple Elevation daughter consigned by M. Robert Young of Lancaster, Pa. Only 16 months of age, she sold to Carnation Milk Farms, Carnation, Washington where she will join her full sister.

Of the five high selling animals, four were by Elevation. The second high entry was an EX-92 Elevation from Tri-Day Farm, Damascus, Md. One of Elevation's greatest, she has records over 21,000 lbs. milk and 900 lbs. of fat. Walter McClure, Ferrum, Va. and Charles Moyer and son purchased her for \$5700 with Cal-Clark Farms of California the contender. Amelio Curti of California purchased MD-Maple-Lawn Elevation Beebee for \$5300. She is a beautiful young Elevation 2 year old consigned by Maple Lawn Farm, Fulton, Md. A young heifer calf that caught the eye of a lot of breeders was

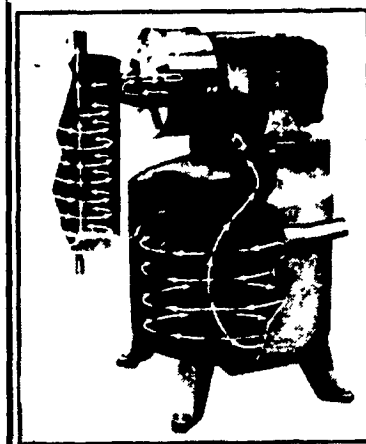
Jay & Mary Houser's 2 month old Elevation Harold Umble of Atglen, Pa. bought her for \$3100.

Throughout the sale, buyers and potential buyers were very enthusiastic and bidding was brisk. Although the sale average was below last year's average, more young stock were selected and offered to the breeders. The top 30 animals sold for an average of \$2199 well above last year's. As in the past, the Kutztown, Pa. Fairgrounds proved to be an ideal setting for the sale.

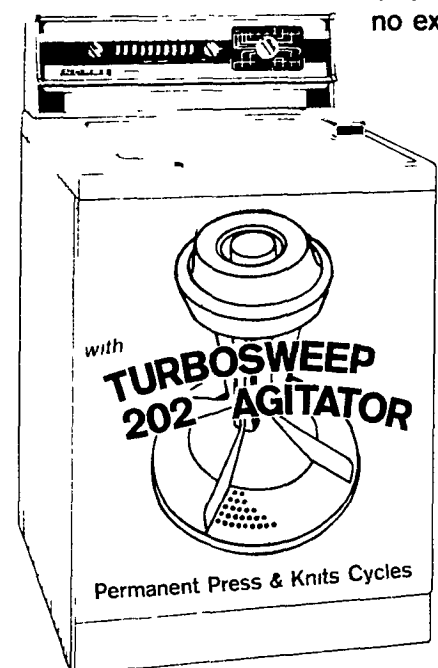

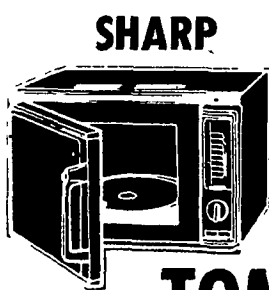

Jay Stauffer also gave a demonstration on beekeeping and the production of honey. Nanette Musser gave a talk on planting and seeding a vegetable garden.

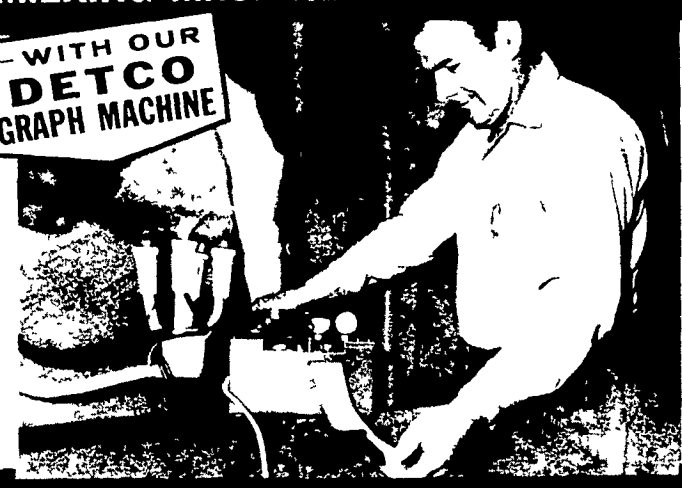
Terrt Longacre from the Manor Township police presented a talk on Summer safety.
