In the open show the junior

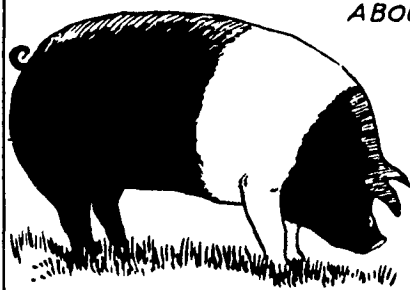

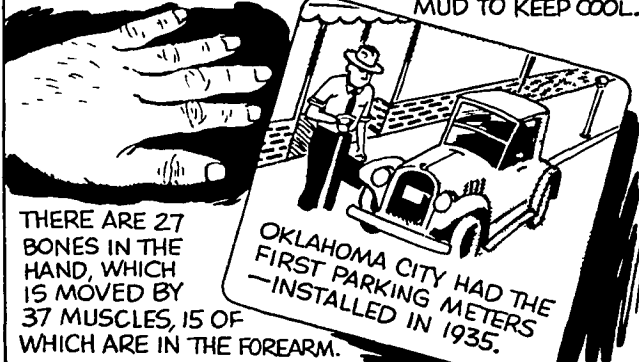
