All told 109 head of stock was competed on with a total purse paid of \$2768.50. The weather not being ideal for outdoor sports there were over 1600 brave people watching Cowtown Rodeo Saturday evening.

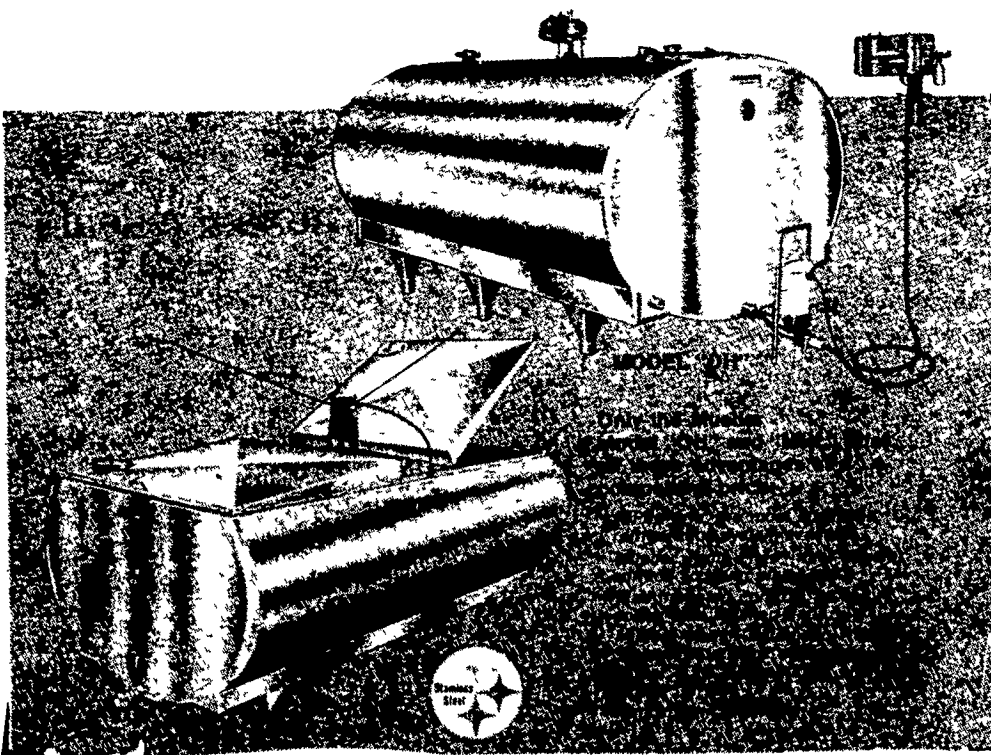
