Proceeding eastward along State Street, the parade will pass by the judges stand, which is

located in the vicinity of Church Street. The parade will move along to South Lime Street and turn off to the Fairgrounds at Park Avenue.

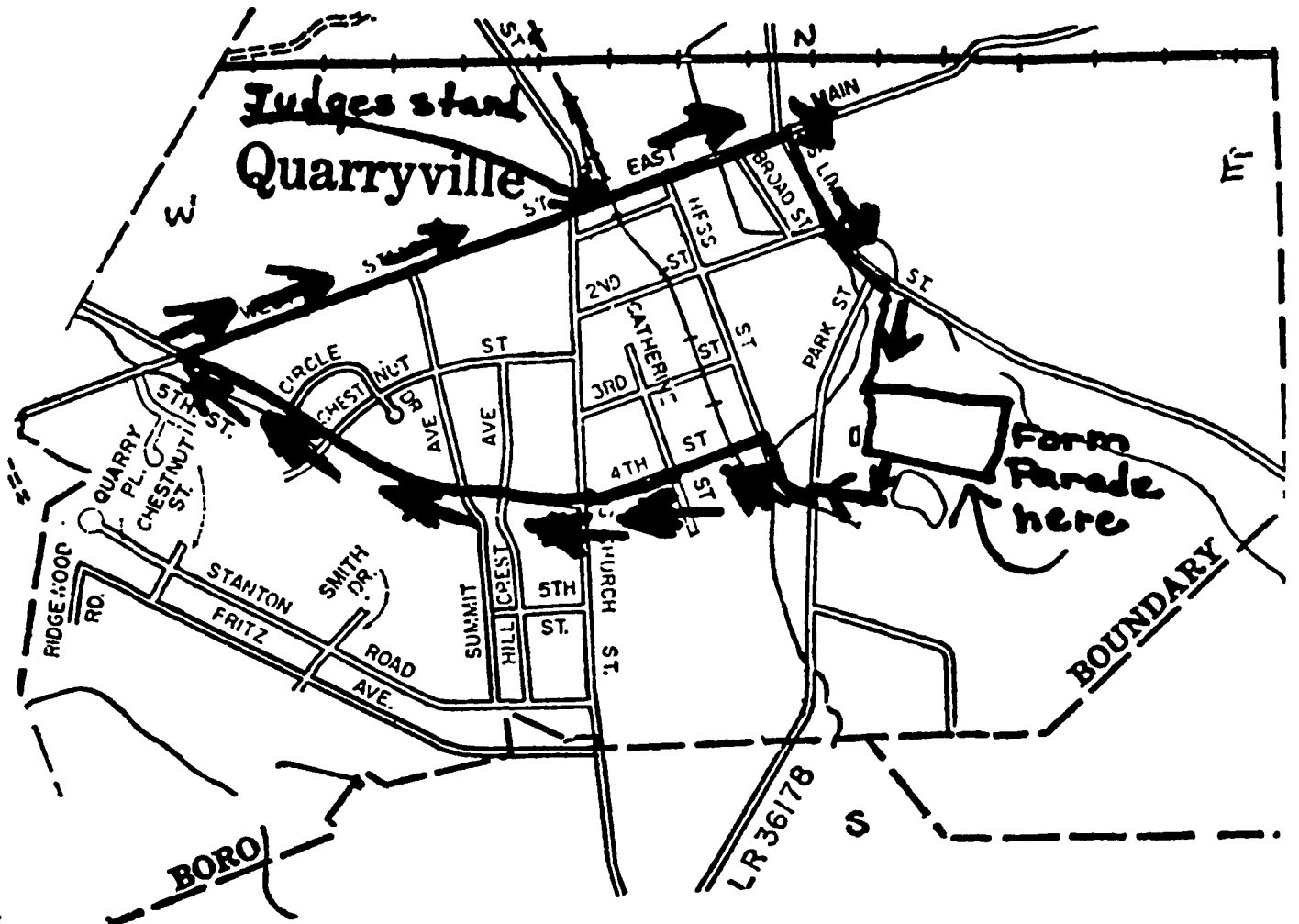
