The time covered starts with July 1, 1974 until June 30, 1975. Applications are available from the Board of Finance and Revenue, Room 130R, Finance Building, Harrisburg, PA 17120. This is a State Tax refund for the benefit of those who produce food and fiber for the consumer.

Applications received after September 30 will not be honored.

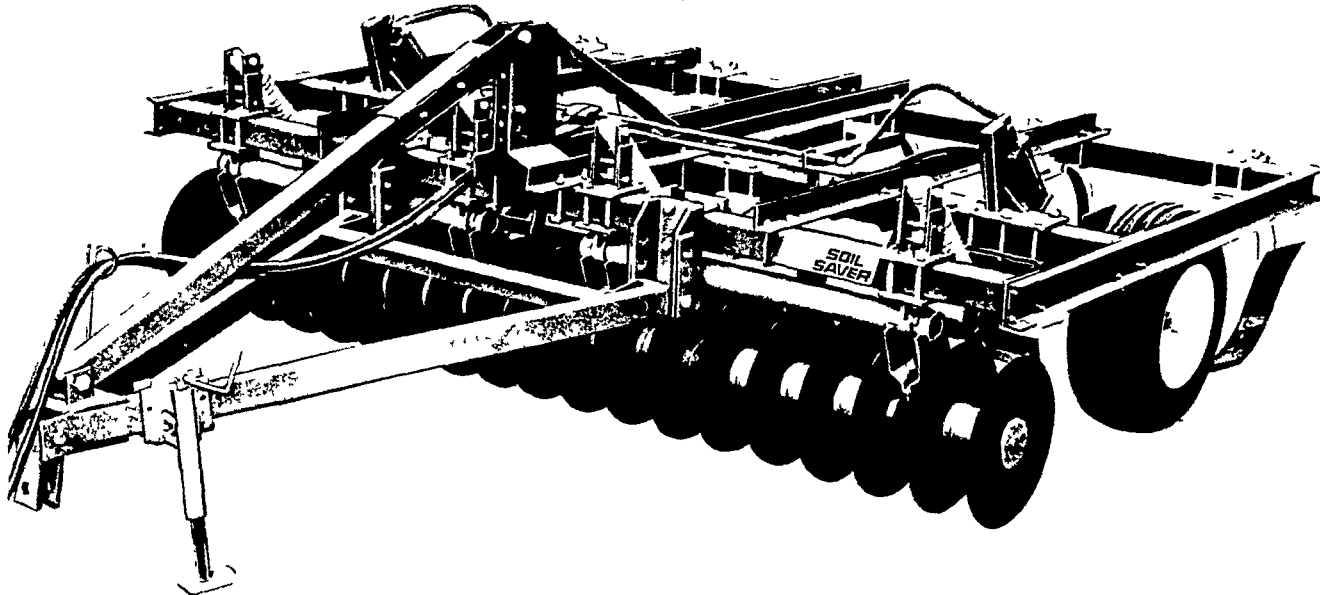
