Unionville Community Fair begins Wednesday

UNIONVILLE — The 51st annual Unionville Community Fair takes place here at the Unionville High School, beginning October 8 and running through until the 11th.

Billed as Chester County's largest display of home and farm products, admission to the four-day fair is free. It is devoted solely to the exhibition of agricultural, domestic, artistic and educational products. It is unique in its philosophy of promoting an educational display and familycommunity activity, rather than the commercialized amusement type fair, fair officials comment.

Through the cooperation of the Unionville-Chadds Ford School District, the Fair Patrons, community organizations and individuals, the fair has grown from a small corn show to an exhibition of its present size and scope.




