

## N.Y. dairymen testify at Meadville

SYRACUSE - Dairy farmers in southwestern New York State and northwestern Pennsylvania made their views known regarding milk pricing conditions in these areas at a hearing in Meadville, Pa. on September 19, 1975.

Tony Wilson of Franklinville, N.Y. headed a panel of Eastern Milk Producers Cooperative members in testifying before the Dairy and Poultry Subcommittee of the House

Agriculture Committee. Congressman Joseph P. Vigorito, the Ranking Majority Member of the Subcommittee, explained that the hearing was held to receive views directly from milk producers and other

interested persons on problems in dairying.

Eastern's panel gave its views on the fact that prices paid by dairy farmers continually climb ever-upward while the prices they receive for milk produced do

not keep pace. Dairymen now receive over \$1.00 per hundredweight less than what is needed to cover their increased cost of production.

Eastern's members indicated that thousands of milk producers have gone out of business in recent years due to tight economic conditions prevailing in the dairy industry. The dairy farmer-member panel requested assistance from Congress to protect those in the milk producing field who provide consumers with fresh wholesome supply of milk and dairy products.

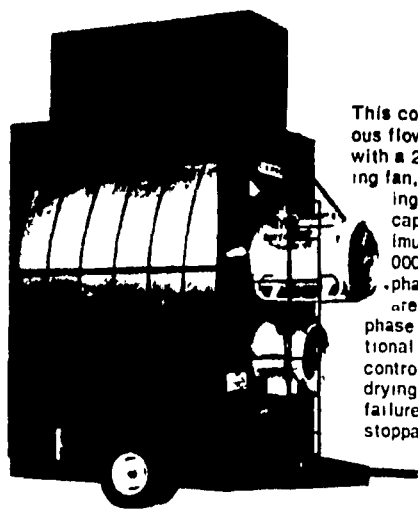
