SYRACUSE - Dairy far- Agriculture Committee. interested persons Congressman Joseph P. Vigorito, the Ranking Majority Member of the Subcommittee, explained that the hearing was held to receive views directly from upward while the prices they milk producers and other

problems in dairying.
