Weekly 51 - CATTLE - Compared with the previous weeks close - closing prices Slaughter Steers and Heifers 25-50 cents lower, instances 75 cents lower in reflection of depressed carcass trade. Most downward pressure on High-Good and Choice 950-1050 lbs. Steers and 750-900 lb. Heifers. High - Utility and Commercial cows firm to 50 cents higher but others weak to 50 cents lower. Bulls steady.

FOUR DAY RECEIPTS 14,100 as compared 14,800 previous week and 14,000 a year ago. Slaughter steers approximately 32 pct. weeks total, Heifers 29 pct. cows 14 pct. and Feeders for Friday auction short 25 pct.

HEIFERS: Monday's supply included large percentage Good and Low - Choice but on later days a fair percentage of Choice although many Steers fell in the 950-1050 lb. weight bracket while most buyer interest centered on heavier weights.
