

Manheim Fair Slated for Oct. 8-11

The 22nd edition of the Manheim Community Farm Show will open to the public on Oct. 8 and will run to the 10th. Numerous activities have been planned for this year's event which range from baby parades to tractor driving contests.

The swine judging and ever popular baby beef livestock contests will take place Wednesday afternoon beginning at 4:00 p.m. A

parade will be held at 7:00 p.m. followed by a tractor pulling event at the livestock tents.

Thursday will mark the dairy judging contest with the evening being donated to the pork producers for their annual Pork King Cookout contest.

The FFA and Adult Tractor driving contests will be staged on Friday with the evening activities to include

the hog and lamb sale. Schwab's Dutch Band will be performing on Friday evening.

The Arts and Crafts will be located in the Community Building with the livestock to be housed in tents near the Boy Scout Hall. Most of the exhibits will be housed in Spahr's Garage.
