A cow in the herd of Ernest P. Detweiler recorded the highest butterfat production for the month of September. Debbie produced 840 pounds of fat with 20,707 pounds of milk. Second high was Donna in the herd of Raymond Getz. The cow produced 837 pounds of fat and 21,308 pounds of milk.

The herd of Arnold Acres was the top recorder in the herd summary for last month. Second high was Willow Maple Farms.
