Trading at mid-week was a forced affair moderate numbers as the meat trade moved lower in a poor demand situation and buying interests had lower ideas, however, the supply of steers and heifers on Wednesday were moved at steady to slightly higher prices with the most noticeable strength on under 1100 lb. steers. Cows steady to instances 50 lower and bulls steady. Receipts about 65 pct. steers, 25 pct. heifers and balance COWS.


