## Main dish casseroles

- 4 1/2 oz. frozen mushrooms
- 2 tablespoons butter
- 1 teaspoon instant minced onion
- 2 tablespoons flour
- 1 cup evaporated milk
- 1/2 teaspoon bottled gravy seasoning
- 1/4 cup dry sauterne wine

Thaw mushrooms. Melt butter in a small saucepan over low heat. Add mushrooms and onion; cook until lightly browned. Sprinkle flour evenly over the browned mushrooms, stirring to blend smoothly. Slowly stir in evaporated milk, and gravy seasoning, keeping sauce smooth. Cook and stir over low heat until thickened. Stir in wine and serve immediately with Rock Cornish Game-Hens.

Makes approximately 2 cups sauce.
