Oatmeal Spice Cookies

- ½ cup sugar
- ½ cup molasses
- 34 cup shortening
- 2 eggs
- 4 cup sweet milk 2 teaspoons cinnamon
- 1 teaspoon cloves 1 teaspoon soda
- 2 cups flour
- 1 cup raisins
- 2 cups oatmeal

Mix ingredients in order given. Drop by teaspoons on greased cookie sheets. Bake at 380 degrees.

XXX Paper Bag Apple Pie

- 6 cups coarsly sliced or chopped apples
- ½ cup sugar
- ½ teaspoon nutmeg
- 2 tablespoons flour 2 tablespoons lemon juice

Measure apples into a bowl, mix with ½ cup sugar, flour, nutmeg and lemon juice.

Turn into unbaked pie

shell. Pat down evenly. Top with ½ cup butter; ½ cup flour, 1/2 cup brown or white sugar. Mix into crumbs and sprinkle over the apples. Slide pie into a brown paper bag tucking the end under the pie. Put on a cookie sheet for easy handling. Bake at 425 degrees for 50 minutes. Dividends: no scorched rim, no underbaked apples and no boiling over in the oven. Lucy Wenger

ples. Pour batter over apples and bake at 350 degrees for 45 minutes.
