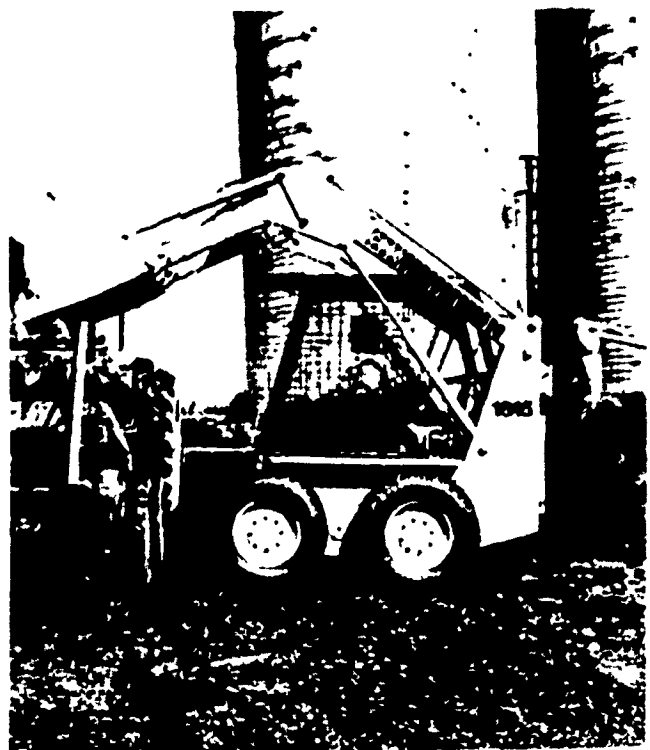

Case Introduces Hydrostatic Uni-Loader
RACINE, Wis. - J I Case Company has expanded its compact loader line with the introduction of the hydrostatic four-wheel drive Model 1845 Uni-Loader.

The 1845 is designed for high production loading of manure spreaders, clean out of barn areas and a multitude of other farm jobs. Compact size and ability to spin-turn in its own length allows the Uni-Loader to work in stock and trench silos, feeding lots, pens, and other close-quarters areas.

A Case-built 45 horsepower (SAE net) water-cooled engine - gasoline or diesel - powers the 1845. The new unit has a 1700 lb. rated lift capacity and features a hinge pin loading height of 9 ft. - 9 in.

Easy to operate dual hand controls are used for steering, forward and reverse travel as well as raising, lowering, and bucket dump. Series hydraulics allow fast, simultaneous loader and bucket operation. Self-leveling loader automatically keeps bucket

level from ground to full lift.

Two separate reservoirs eliminate the possibility of the loader's hydrostatic system being contaminated by the final drive system. Other design features aimed at minimum service and maintenance include drive chains that can be checked and tension-adjusted in minutes, without removing wheels.

Standard equipment includes parking brake, ROPS (Roll-over protective structure) canopy, adjustable seat, seat belt, and tool tach for quick attachment change. Bucket options include dirt, utility, fertilizer, stock-yard, snow, and litter buckets. Manure forks and grapples add to the 1845's work versatility. Model D-100 or D-130 backhoes can be used for digging tile lines, septic systems, and other farm related operations.

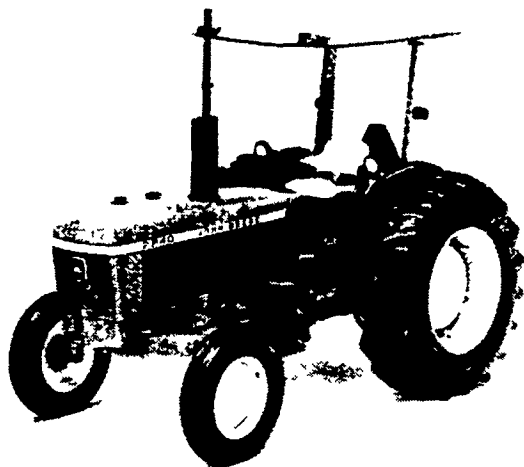
