Hog system unveiled

Farmers from throughout Pennsylvania are expected to gather at the Harvey Veldhuizen Farm near Greencastle from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Friday, November 14 to view one of the most modern hog finishing systems in the state.

The Veldhuizen Farm is located northwest of Greencastle. Open house signs will be posted along the route. The attraction is a total confinement hog finishing system. The 86 foot long by 38 foot wide building

will finish approximately 1,500 hogs yearly.

Everything in the system is designed to reduce labor and increase the efficiency of hog production. Automatic feeding and a work saving manure handling system will cut the workload of Veldhuizen and leave more time for the important task of management. Specially designed pen partitions, a floor feeding system and a high capacity ventilation system will give hogs the proper environment for top production.
