Omaha Auction

Nov. 28
Weekly \$1 - Cattle - Compared with the previous weeks close - Closing prices average - good to Prime slaughter steers 1.50-2.50 higher than previous midweek. Standard and below - Good holsteins steady to 50 cents higher. Heifers 1.00-1.50 higher with late supplies barely sufficient to afford a good market test. Cows in improved demand 1.00-1.50 higher. Bulls steady to 1.00 lower.

Three day receipts 13,500 as compared 14,300 previous week and 14,600 a year ago.

Steers approximately 45 pct., Heifers 40 percent and cows 13 pct. pre-Thanksgiving demand good with midweek activity further stimulated by bad weather conditions which threatened livestock movement. But, even on a Monday run of 7500 head prices sharply higher as most interests in need of cattle for immediate requirements. In contrast to many years during the holiday period, demands for carcass beef was fairly good. The local run included a fair percentage Choice steers but the Heifer consist again more attractive than steers with a moderate volume Choice and Prime on offer.

Standard and low - Good 39.50-41.50, load Utility and standard Holsteins 37.50.

The average of LS-214, detailed quotations, Forg Choice 900-1100 lb. steers this week 46.90, Choice 1100-1300 lbs. 47.38.

Trade moderate, a light offering of slaughter cows remained generally steady, instances 25 cents higher, slaughter bulls and slaughter heifers not established.

Feeder cattle mostly steady on weights under 700 lb., weights over 700 lb. untested. Majority receipts good and choice 400-700 lb. feeder steers, 300-600 lb. feeder heifers; cows and bulls near 10 percent. Feeders 90 percent of total.

Salable supply this week totaled near 8,700 head compared to 24,191 last week and 5,499 last year. Cows and bulls comprised near 22 percent feeders, 72 percent of total.
