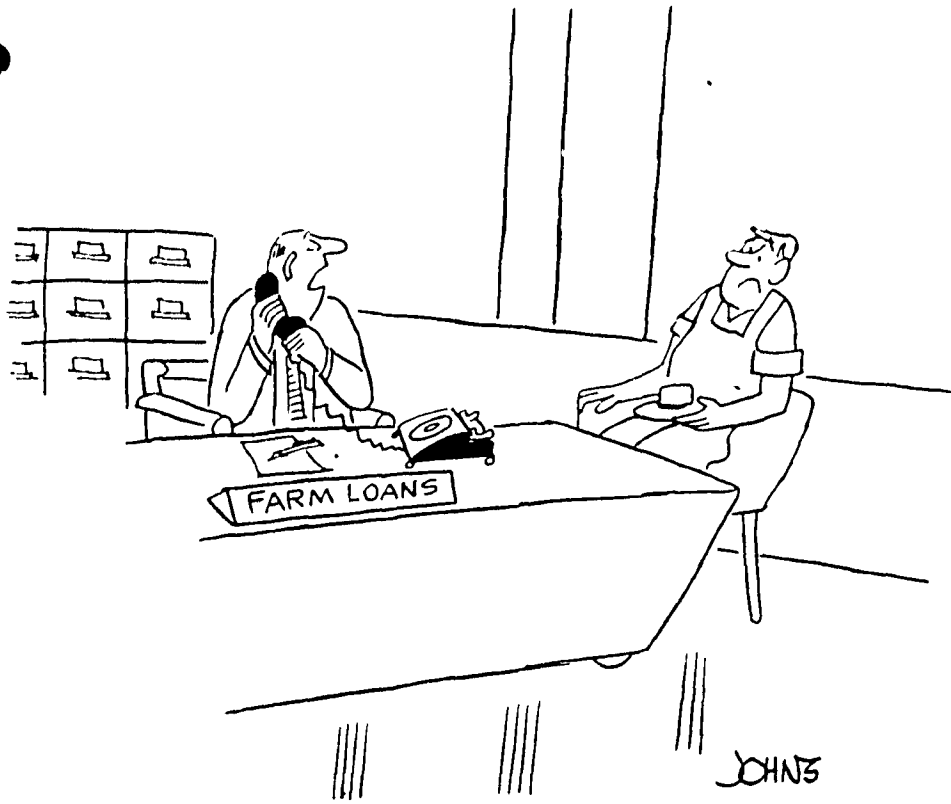

Quick-Mount Loader
A heavy-duty front end loader that attaches or detaches in less than five minutes has been introduced by Farmhand, Inc., farm equipment manufacturer based here.

Lift capacity of the new loader is 3200 lbs. to its full lift height of 13'4". Reach at maximum lift is 41" and the dump angle is 36". It has a breakaway of 4500 lbs. A wrap-around subframe with various mountings lets the F235 mount a wide range of tractors, with or without cabs.

When stands on both sides of the loader are secured, hydraulics are activated to lift the loader from the frame. The tractor is free to back away when the hydraulic hoses are disconnected. No tools are necessary to mount or dismount the loader.

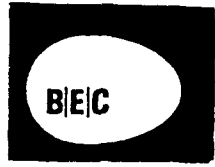
Other features of the F235 include 3" double-acting lift and tilt cylinders with a 2" chromed rod. Tractor hydraulics may be used to power the loader, of Far-



mand's high-gallonage PTO pump that increases lift speed by up to 100 percent is also available. With either grapple forks, a hay basket with hookup, valves are mounted on the subframe with remote controls to the operator.

Eleven attachments are interchangeable using

Farmhand's exclusive attachment carrier. Available are six scoops, two grapple forks, a hay basket with hydraulic push-off and a choice of manure forks. The 5' attachment carrier serves as a dozer blade when attachments are removed.

The special anti-perch shape prevents birds from fouling the drinker and the valve system is extremely simple to ensure continuous water supply. The large flat filter is easily removed for cleaning and all fittings are self-sealing with no 'O' rings or washers needed. Watermasters are supplied complete with the BEC saddle connector, 10 ft. of tubing and suspension. Recommended stocking rate is as follows:
8 Watermasters for every 1000 broilers
10 Watermasters per 1000 rearing pullets
10 Watermasters per 1000 layers

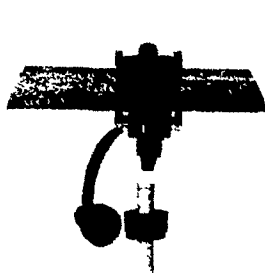


Recent Watermaster 2s are designed to work in conjunction with BEC Minimaster 2s thus eliminating the chore of jug filling. It has been clearly proved that availability of water at the maximum number of points rather than the intricacy of individual waterers is the prime factor in avoiding dehydration.
