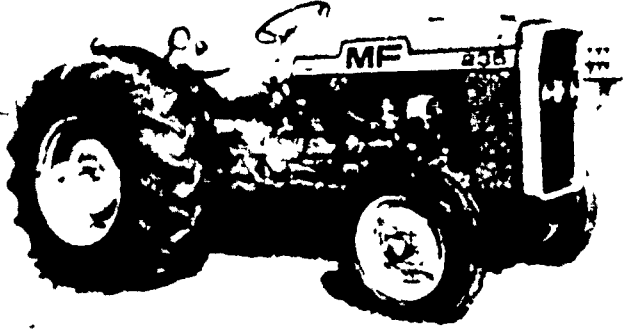


What's New . . .



A new gasoline-powered model of the MF 235 agricultural tractor has been introduced by Massey-Ferguson Inc., as a companion model to the diesel-engine MF 235 introduced early in 1975. The new tractor features a Continental Z145 four-cylinder engine rated at 40 PTO horsepower at 2250 rpm.

Gas-Powered MF
235 Tractor**

A new gasoline-powered model of the MF 235 agricultural tractor has been introduced by Massey-Ferguson Inc. Featuring a Continental Z145 four-cylinder engine rated at 40 PTO horsepower at 2250 rpm, the new version is a companion model to the 42 hp Perkins diesel-engine MF

235 introduced earlier this year.

Identical in overall appearance, the gasoline model MF 235 has the same "new look," greater serviceability and design improvements incorporated into the other "200 series" tractors. It is offered for operators who prefer gasoline to diesel power.

Two chassis types are available: Standard Clearance with traditional

MF swept-back front axle or adjustable straight front axle, or low-profile Orchard with heavy fixed tread front axle and disc brake rear axle.

For easy serviceability, the MF 235 has a removable hood, side panels and grille screen for quick access to the engine area, battery, oil cooler, radiator, and hydraulic lines. The fuel tank filler cap and radiator cap extend through the hood for rapid ground level servicing.

Standard equipment includes the full-range Advanced Ferguson System hydraulics, featuring exclusive draft and position control with three-point linkage.

Live or full independent PTO is optional. Other options include 12-speed Multi-Power or manual 6- or 8-speed transmissions, manual or power-assist steering, and a new spring suspension seat with deluxe cushion assembly with high, full width backrest. ROPS is available.

Insecticide Available
DALLAS Tx. - Thuron Industries, Inc. has announced that recent amendments to Federal regulations by the USDA will allow one of its products -

GX-118 - a grub and louse cattle insecticide - to also now be used as a dip against psoroptic cattle scabies.

The product, marketed by Thuron's Starbar Division, contains Prolate. A series of trials conducted by the USDA and Thuron demonstrated that Prolate, an organophosphorous compound, is effective against scabies in vat solutions. This is a real advantage in that some pesticides can only be used in sprays.

Previously permitted dips for scabies included heated lin sulphur, toxaphene, and coumophos.

Starbar's GX-118, an emulsifiable concentrate, has previously been registered with the EPA for dip vat use against grubs, lice, hornflies, cattle ticks and Southern cattle ticks. The biodegradable products also may be used as a pour-on or spray-on application.

Dallas-based Thuron, incorporated under its present name in 1962, researches, develops, manufactures and markets a variety of chemical products which control insects and parasites harmful to pets, food producing animals and to humans. Since 1970, Thuron has been a subsidiary of Zoecon Corporation, a publicly held Palo Alto, California, firm whose stock is listed and traded on the Pacific Coast Stock Exchange.

Thuron's Starbar Division is responsible for marketing products for use on farm and ranches. Products are sold to about 100 regional distributors throughout the United States who sell to approximately 4,000 Starbar registered dealerships.

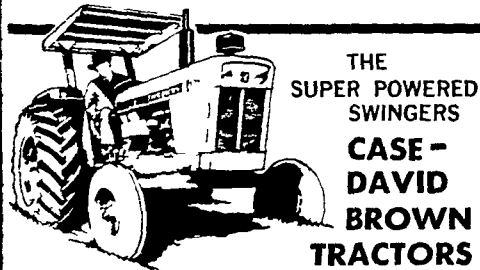
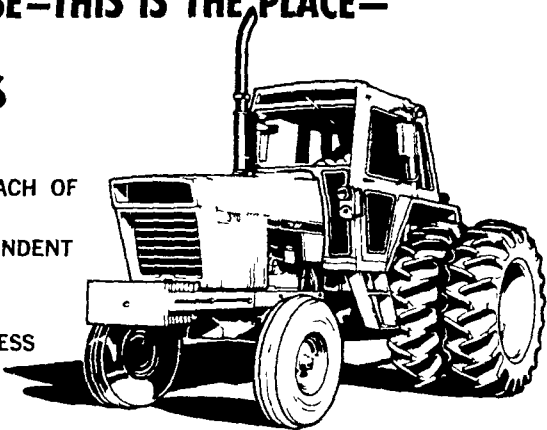

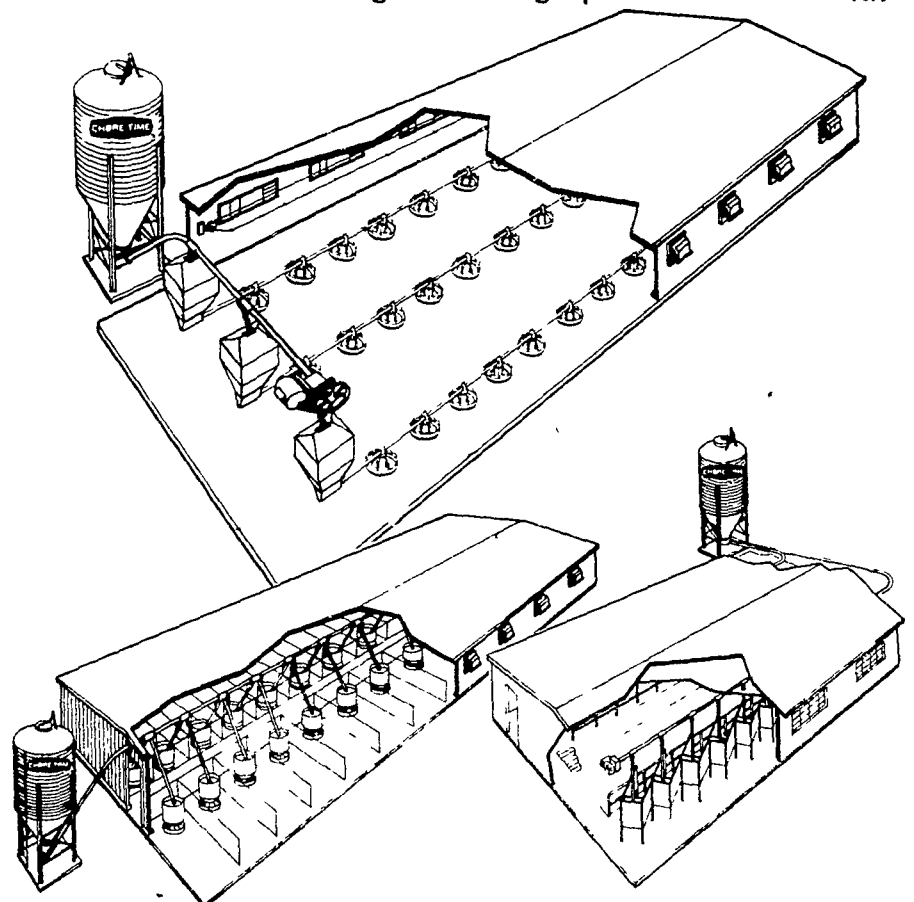
