



The needles on pine trees grow in clusters or groups. The pines most frequently sold in this area are the Scotch, Austrian, and white.

Scotch and Austrian pines have two needles bound together at the base. The Scotch has medium-soft needles about 11/2 to 3 inches long. Austrian pine needles are very stiff and 3 to 4 inches long.

White pine trees always have five needles in a cluster. An easy way to remember this is one needle


