CATTLE Receipts this week 7500; last week: 8500; year ago 5000.

Compared with last weeks close, slaughter steers 50-1 00 lower Slaughter heifers closing 2 00-3 00 lower. Cows 50-1 00 higher Bulls steady Receipts about 55 percent slaughter steers, 25 percent slaughter heifers, balance mainly cows. Slaughter steers and heifers were lower this week under the influence of a depressed dress trade with most decline on heifer beef. Cows near 20 percent of the receipts about double.
