



Berks COUNTY DHIA MONTHLY REPORT

Charles Plushanski's herd of registered Guernseys and Holsteins topped the November DHIA herd averages in Berks County with 1.97 pounds of butterfat produced per cow per day. The high individual butterfat and milk records produced in 305 days or less was turned in by Andrew D. Stoltzfus's "Daisy." Her completed record, begun at the age of six years, 9 months, reads: 23,522 pounds of milk and 925 pounds of butterfat.
