



Lebanon DHIA MONTHLY REPORT

Edwin Funk's 40 Holsteins took first place in Lebanon County's DHIA summary for December, running .08 pounds of butterfat per head per day ahead of the second-place herd, owned by Norman Kline.

The highest individual butterfat production record belonged to a 10-year-old Holstein in the Melvin Horst herd. She put out 883 pounds. The champion milk producer for the month was Willow Maple Farm's "Luna," a five-year-old Holstein who pumped out 26,145 pounds.

Following are county herd averages exceeding 1.25 pounds of butterfat per cow per day.

The center of the arc, 40 degrees in radius, is always on line with the observer and the sun. When you see a rainbow, the sun is directly behind you. Sometimes a secondary rainbow forms. Its colors are fainter—and reversed, red inside, violet outside.
