Grain hearing moved

Individuals and organizations affected by changes in the grain inspection regulations proposed by the U. S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) in the Feb. 12 Federal Register will be given more time to comment, USDA officials announced.

To provide ample opportunity for preparation of data, views, and arguments from interested parties, the comment period will be

extended from Feb. 19 to March 4. A public hearing originally scheduled for Feb. 19 has also been rescheduled for March 4.

The public hearing will be held at 9 a.m. on Room 2096, South Building, USDA, 14th Street and Independence Ave., S.W., Washington, D.C. An official designated by the Secretary of Agriculture will receive testimony from those wishing to present their views orally.

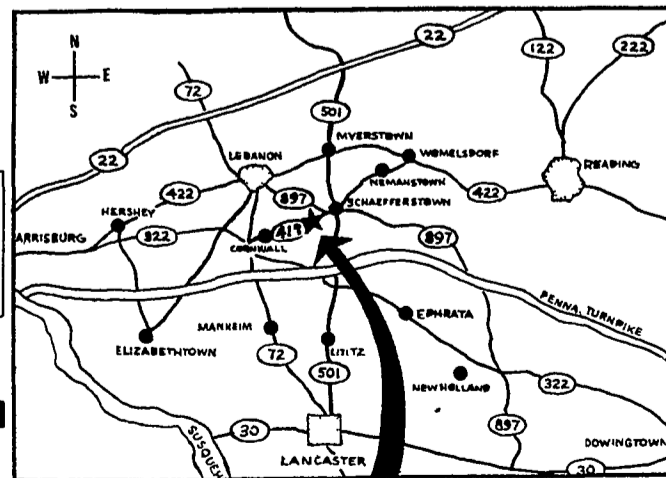
