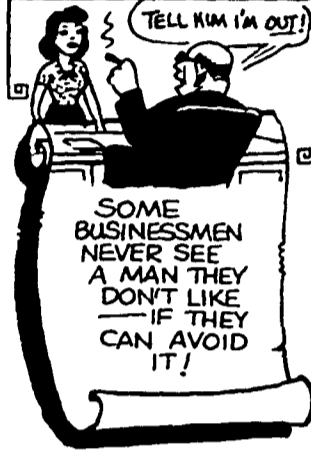
bachelor of science degree in secondary education from State University College at Buffalo, Buffalo, New York.

The daughter of Mr. and Mrs. D. Brooks Main, Fillmore, New York, she is married to William J. Franz III. They make their home in Lancaster.

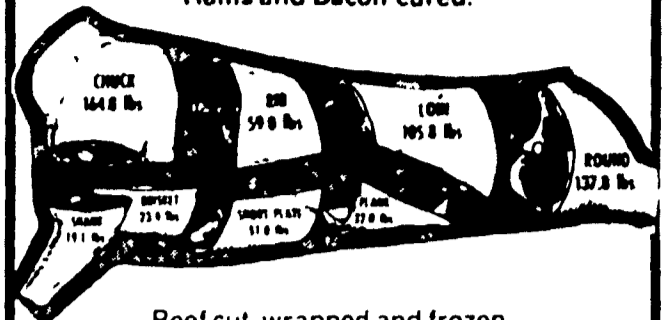
