



Lancaster COUNTY DHIA MONTHLY REPORT

JANUARY 1976

A registered Holstein cow owned by Lancaster Menonite Hospital Farm, Lebanon R5, completed the highest 305 day lactation. Unellie produced 25,941 pounds of milk, 979 pounds of butterfat with a 3.8 percent test. Second high lactation was completed by a registered Holstein cow owned by John P. Lapp, Leola R1. Lin produced 22,140 pounds of milk, 945 pounds of butterfat with a 4.3 percent test in 305 days.

The herd of Henry B. Leaman, 1891 Windy Hill Road, Lancaster, had the highest daily butterfat average. This herd of 29 registered & grade Holstein cows averaged 52.4 pounds of milk, 2.26 pounds of butterfat with a 4.3 percent test. The herd of Aaron E. Beiler, Paradise, placed second. This herd of 25 registered & grade Holstein cows averaged 51.2 pounds of milk, 2.21 pounds of butterfat with a 4.3 percent test.
