A public sale of Farm Equipment, Woodland and Antiques was sold Feb. 28 by Ammon S. Nolt near Churchtown, Pa.

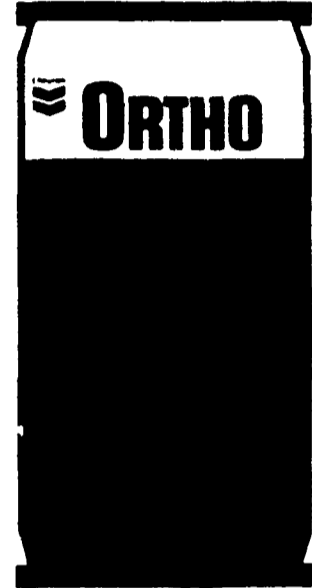
The 6 acres of woodland sold for \$7900. There was a large attendance.

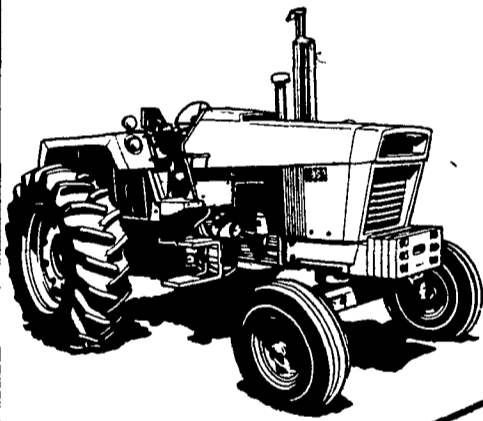
