CATTLE AND CALVES:
Compared with the previous week's close: Slaughter Steers 1.00-2.00 lower, many mixed 3-4 1.50-2.00 off. Heifers 1.00-1.50 lower. Cows firm to 50 higher. Bulls weak.

Four Day Receipts 15,400 as compared 11,900 previous week and 17,600 a year ago. Slaughter steers and heifers again under severe downward pressure forepart of week in slow deliberate trade. Buyers again quite selective with loadlots carrying substantial percentage yield grade 4 animals in generally poor demand. Day-to-day distribution of supply poor with 55 pct. arriving on Monday.

STEERS: Forepart of week, three loads Choice and Prime 3-4 1150-1223 lbs. 36.50-37.00, load 3-4 1267 lbs. 35.00 and load mostly 4 1353 lbs. 34.00. Closing trade Choice 2-4 975-1225 lbs. 35.25-36.50, load mostly Choice 2-3 1050 lbs. for Canadian shipment 36.00. Mixed Good and Choice 2-3 950-1150 lbs. 34.50-35.50. Good 2-3 33.00-34.50. Standard and low-Good 2-3 32.00-33.00.


