HERD RECORD:

Mr. Yoder's herd average of 18,286 pounds of milk and 719 pounds of butterfat has set a new ROCKY-SIDE herd high for both milk and butterfat production. During the 1975 DHIA year, 22 ROCKY-SIDE cows completed lactations exceeding 20,000 pounds of milk with the high cow producing 29,009 pounds. Seven of these same cows produced over 1,000 pounds of butterfat with the high cow producing 1,293 pounds. At the 1975 herd classification, 4 cows scored Excellent, 13 Very Good, 27 Good Plus and 10 Good.

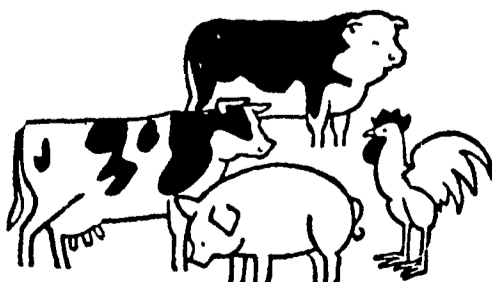
FEEDING PROGRAM:

Mr. Yoder feeds his milking cows 35 pounds of corn silage, all the hay (mixed legume-grass) they can eat and BROWN'S 16 ROYAL on a 3 to 1 basis. Dry cows are fed mixed hay free choice plus 8 pounds of grain. No corn silage is fed to the dry cows.
