### U. of Delaware asks for new agriculture building

Two years ago, University of Delaware agricultural sciences administrators were asking themselves whether there would be a college of agriculture in a few years. Today, says Dr. William E. McDaniel, Dean of the College of Agricultural Sciences, there has been a 500 percent growth increase in agricultural students, and the 1962 building is bursting at the seams.

McDaniel says the University is currently

requesting \$8 million from the state legislature for a new building to house the College of Agricultural Sciences, the Delaware Cooperative Extension Service, and the Delaware Agricultural Experiment Station, now all crowded into one-half of the area they need. Plans are to construct a new building adjacent to the existing one with an additional 44,000 square feet of usable office, classroom, and laboratory space.

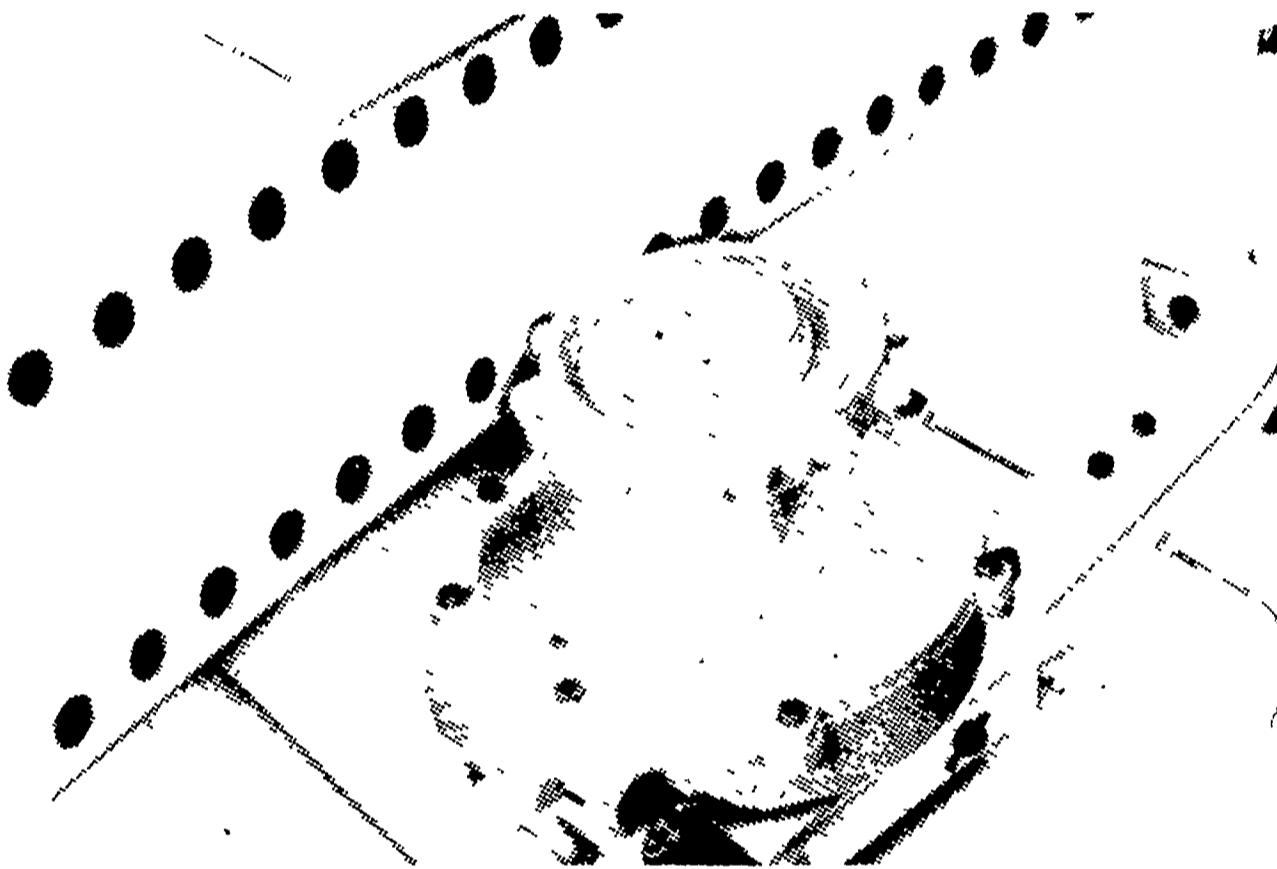


