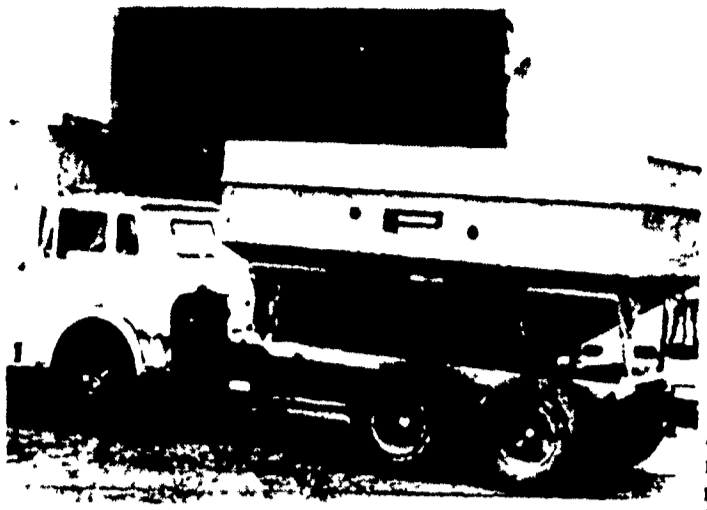

Super Ox Cart had Fast-Action Discharge; The Super Ox Cart, manufactured by Parker Industries, Inc. Silver Lake, Indiana, features a 310 bushel bed capacity plus the advantage of center unloading for fast, complete unloading of high moisture grain. With optional sideboards it carries up to 425 bushels.

The convenient center-unloading bed design of the Super Ox Cart helps achieve a more balanced load. The natural force of gravity pulls material to the center of the bed. Big double doors and steep sloped sides speed up discharge of grain at the wet holding bin or elevator. The four big doors can be locked open for desired material flow, then easily released for instant flow stoppage. Versatile design allows

material to be unloaded from either side.

Engs, sides and bottom of the Super Ox Cart are formed of heavy 14 gauge prime steel with heavy-duty superstructure members of formed steel plate. All seams are welded and lapped for a smoother inside surface and to provide extra strength. Rear corners are triple reinforced to prevent twisting and splitting.

The Super Ox Cart handles all types of grain, shelled corn, ear corn, dry feeds and bulk fertilizers. For maximum versatility, it can be mounted on wagon gear, truck chassis, or on a fifth-wheel flatbed trailer.

New Bulletin Describes Woodsman Land Clearing Machines

KINGSTON, Pa. - The Woodsman, a rugged machine that clears land by cutting a 5'-wide swath through dense brush and trees, is described in Bulletin 6000, recently published by Robert Foundry & Machine

Co. According to the bulletin, the Woodsman can clear up to 3 acres of land in a day and easily handle 6" diameter trees.
