Resolutions considered at Pomona Grange meeting

LEESPORT - A total of 185 persons attended the all-day meeting of the Pomona Grange No 43 at the Berks Agricultural Building on March 6. Saturday was designated as Youth Day for the Berks County Grange and of those members present, 33 were Junior members ranging from ages five to 14, and approximately one-quarter of the total attendance was comprised of

Youth Group members who range in age from 14 to 35 years. Representatives of the Youth Group conducted the meeting with the regular County officers standing by their side. The highlights of the meeting were the passage of two major resolutions by the membership, the presentation of subordinate Grange awards and a Literary Program presentation.

Regarding State Bill 1266 which would amend Section 1501 of the School Code to

allow that the fulfillment of the 180-day requirement for pupil instruction in Pennsylvania public schools be waived in the event of a work stoppage or strike, and that the school year would be the actual number of days taught for the affected district, the Pomona Grange No 43 passed a resolution to urge the passage of the bill with the amendment that "the state reimbursement to the school district be prorated on the actual days of instruction if it is less than the 180-day school year," providing an incentive for the school board to have 180-days of instruction.

Another resolution considered by the group was in regard to Lady Bird Johnson's Highway Beautification Act passed in 1965. The Grange members voted to support an amendment to the Act which would allow small business establishments such as restaurants, motels, hotels, and service stations to erect billboards, provided they are properly maintained, no

closer to the highways than the 660-foot distance now required by the Act for any sign not in commercial or industrial zones or on premise properties. The Grange members agreed that the Act as it stands is a detriment to tourists who depend on billboards for locating food, fuel and lodging along their travel routes, and that it discriminates against the small businessman because of the prohibitive cost for them of erecting a sign large enough to be seen at a distance of 660 feet.

Following the awarding of Honorary Grange Memberships to Robert Kelly, Arline Herring and Paul Miller, the Youth Group presented the Literary Program entitled "Tour the U.S.A." In addition to several group efforts, the program included a piano solo by Barry Driesbach, the "Gettysburg Address" by David Brown, and a duet, "Gold Bless America," performed by Jane Hill and Jeffrey Wetzel.
