"Spring Happenings" was the theme of the March 25th meeting with several skits being given by members of the grange.

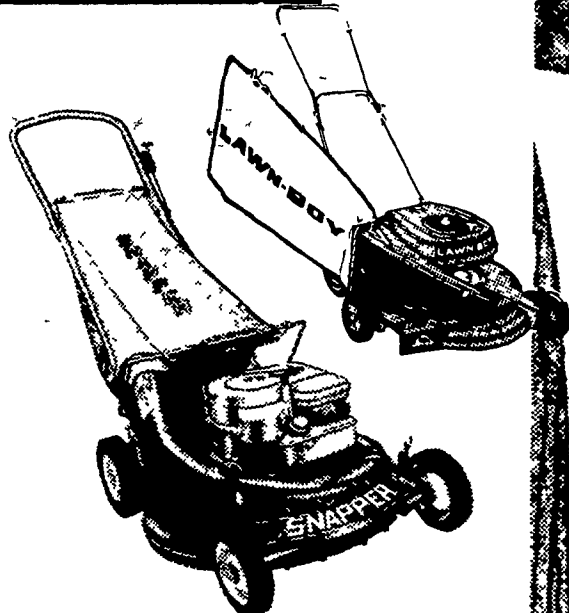
