The board operates under a federal marketing order for red tart cherries grown in Michigan, New York. Wisconsin, Ohio, Penn-sylvania, Virginia, West Virginia, and Maryland.


vegetable official with USDA's Agricultural Marketing Service, said a major function of the board year.

is to analyze supply and demand conditions and recommend to USDA the total quantity of cherries that may be shipped under the marketing order during specified time periods. This helps stablize supplies and prevents market shortages and gluts.

The board consists of 12 members - six producers and six handlers - with an alternate for each. The marketing order, Dever George Dever, fruit and explained, specifies a threeyear term of office, with terms of one-third the members expiring each


