

Penn State ag alums to meet

UNIVERSITY PARK-The 9th annual College of Agriculture Alumni Association meeting at Penn State University will be held on campus Saturday, May 8. Registration will be underway from 8 a.m. until noon. The annual business meeting will start at 9 a.m. Both activities will be held in the Agricultural Administration Building. In charge of the business meeting will be alumni president Lois M. Stringer of Doylestown. Newly elected directors will be announced. At 9:45 the association will

tour the various departmental buildings to see Bicentennial exhibits. Each department in the College of Agriculture will have an exhibit commemorating the 200 years of the nation. A picnic luncheon will be held at 12:15 in the Hort Woods near the football stadium. In charge of preparing barbecued chicken will be Frank Anthony, class of 1934, professor of agricultural education. The Ag Alumni Weekend will include a 2 o'clock demonstration of an old

Pennsylvania-made threshing machine powered by a horse treadmill, as well as a stationary hay baler powered by a horse moving in a circle. This equipment will be shown by Robert L. Cowan, professor of animal nutrition. The annual Blue-White football game is also slated for 2 p.m. and will be followed by a repeat demonstration of the horse-powered equipment.

The annual alumni banquet will be held at 7 p.m. in the Hetzel Union Building. The program will feature a re-creation of a lecture by the first President of Penn State, Dr. Evan Pugh, as presented by Jerome K. Pasto, Associate Dean of the College of Agriculture. The re-creation of Pugh will be introduced by Dr. James E. Van Horn of the faculty.

The banquet will also feature Alumni Association awards to outstanding students. Chairman of the program committee is William P. Moore of Chatham.

Cherry board expanded

Appointment of four members and their alternates to the Cherry Administrative Board was announced recently by the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA). The board operates under a federal marketing order for red tart cherries grown in Michigan, New York, Wisconsin, Ohio, Pennsylvania, Virginia, West Virginia, and Maryland.

is to analyze supply and demand conditions and recommend to USDA the total quantity of cherries that may be shipped under the marketing order during specified time periods. This helps stabilize supplies and prevents market shortages and gluts.

The board consists of 12 members - six producers and six handlers - with an alternate for each. The marketing order, Dever explained, specifies a three-year term of office, with terms of one-third the members expiring each year.

George Dever, fruit and vegetable official with USDA's Agricultural Marketing Service, said a major function of the board

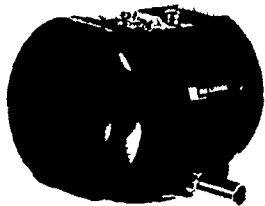
