

# Nat'l. 4-H unit begins operation

CHICAGO - A new chapter in 4-H history will open when the National 4-H Council goes into operation on or about July 1.

A nonprofit educational corporation, the Council will unify functions of the National 4-H Foundation, Washington, D.C., and the National 4-H Service Committee, Chicago. The two organizations for many years have represented 4-H nationally on behalf of the private sector.

The new Council is expected to strengthen the private sector's role as an effective partner in the overall 4-H program conducted by the Cooperative Extension Service.

Funds from business, industry and foundations channeled through the Service Committee and the Foundation have supplemented public support of 4-H by making possible such extras as educational materials, citizenship-

leadership training courses, international travel and youth exchange programs, operation and expansion of National 4-H Center, and awards that recognize the achievements of 4-H'ers in a broad range of projects.

Some private-sector donors have lent their support to 4-H through the Service Committee for more than half a century. Among them are International Harvester Company, donor of awards in the 4-H agricultural program; Montgomery Ward & Co., consumer education program; Wilson & Co., Inc., sheep program; Armour & Company, general support; The Santa Fe Railway System and Gulf Central Pipeline Company, A Santa Fe Industries Company, educational awards and scholarships; Chicago & North Western Transportation Company, college scholarships; and The Milwaukee Road, grain marketing - transportation scholarships.

Donors supporting 4-H for more than 30 years include Kerr Glass Manufacturing Corp., food preservation program; Westinghouse Electric Corporation, electric energy; Coats & Clark Inc., clothing; The Firestone Tire & Rubber Company, automotive; Amoco Foundation, Inc., petroleum power; and General Motors, safety program. These donors are among about 30 that offer a full schedule of awards to 4-H members: medals of honor at the county level, expense-paid trips to National 4-H Congress for state winners, and national college scholarships.

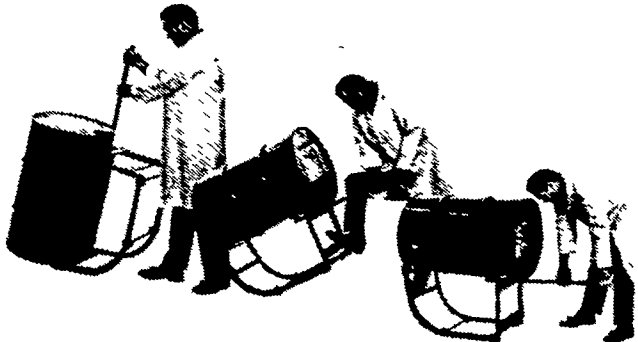

awards to winners of special 4-H events.

Hundreds of other private-

sector donors have been partners in the 4-H program through the years. Private resources channeled through the new Council are expected to help the Extension Service reach its goal of involving more young people in 4-H by the close of the 1970s.

**Rocking Drum Stand**  
Weil Rocking Drum Stands offer a simple, safe method for one man to safely and efficiently drain a 30 to 55 gallon drum. The stand is slipped under the upright drum, then drum and stand are rocked back to a horizontal drainage position. Drainage is facilitated by the use of a drum faucet.

Rockers make excellent drum storage racks and can be located wherever they offer greatest convenience in the plant. Waste and spillage are avoided, and plant safety is increased. Faucet height is a comfortable 18 inches; models with 24 inch lift are also available. A drum up-ender handle is offered as an optional accessory with 18 inch lift models; a length of tubular steel with a welded lip hook and plastic handgrip, it gives added leverage which makes rocking the drum much easier. The added lift provided by the 24 inch models requires two men to safely rock the drum into position.
