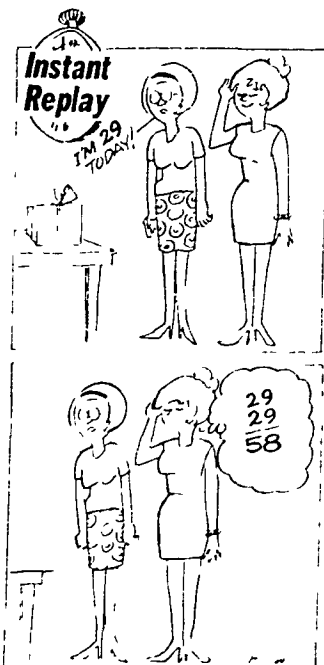

Drug law violation statistics

Failure to follow preslaughter withdrawal times for animal drugs reportedly accounted for 72 percent of violative tissue residues in food producing animals, including poultry, during the first half of '75. Other residue violation causes reported were: suspected feed mixing or feed delivery error, 15 percent inadequate storage bin cleaning, eight percent; and failure to state withdrawal times on drug labels or feed tags, five percent.

The report was compiled from 85 of 106 investigations where FDA inspectors were able to pinpoint a possible cause for an illegal residue. 53 percent of the residue violations could be traced to the use of medicated feeds.

The scholarship, administered by the Dairy Shrine Club, is funded by employees of UDIA.

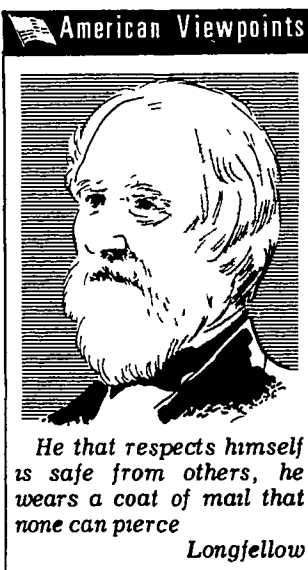
One student per year will be awarded \$1,000 toward the freshman year study of dairy marketing, dairy manufacturing, home economics, ag journalism or related field.

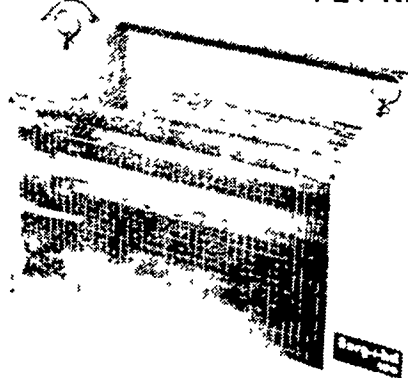

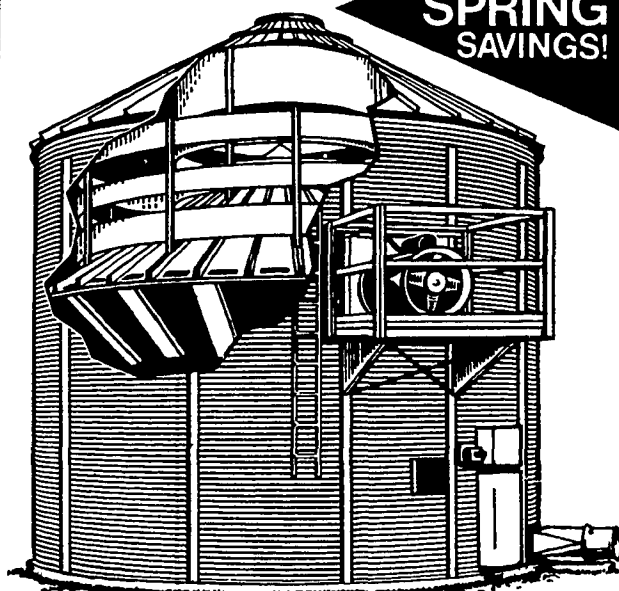
