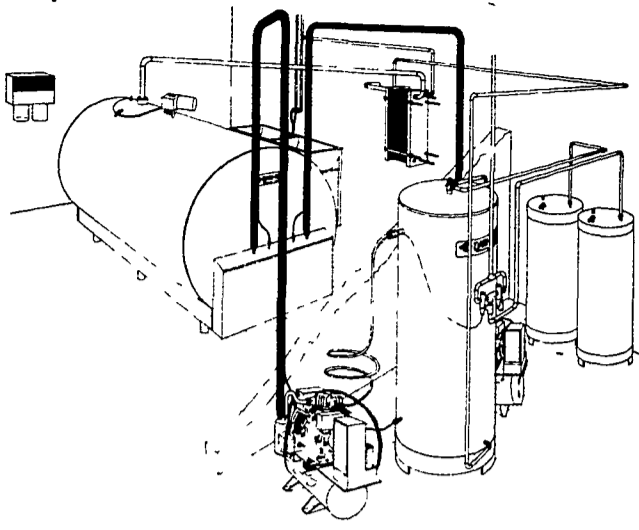

The mid-Atlantic milk marketing district will hold a meeting concerning new advertising proposals. The hearing takes place at 10 a.m. at the Friendship International Inn,

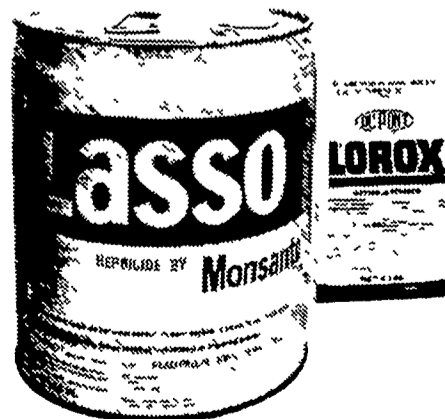
