Resource stewardship week proclaimed

HARRISBURG — Pennsylvania Governor Milton J. Shapp has proclaimed the week of May 23, 1976, as Resource Stewardship Week in the Commonwealth. Shapp commented that "the well-being of our people depends upon the production and ample supply of food, fibre and other products of the soil. The quality and quantity of these products in turn depend upon the conservation, wise and proper management of the soil and water resources."

Governor Shapp went on to say "our people have a

mutual interest in the land and share the responsibility of preserving its productivity. Conservation Districts provide our people with a practical and democratic organization through which they, as landowners, are taking the initiative to conserve and make proper use of these resources. For this reason, the conservation districts are carrying forward a special program of soil and water conservation in cooperation with numerous agencies and countless individuals throughout our State."

CROP PROGRAMS:

1. PASTURES: For control of wild onion and garlic, dandelions, thistles, and many more, apply 1 pint 2, 4-D Amine plus 1/2 pint Banvel per acre. Do not graze for 7 days.
 2. ALFALFA:
 - a. Broadleaf-weed control, new seedlings: Apply Butyrac 200 at 2 to 3 quarts per acre. Use light rate when alfalfa is less than 3 inches tall and absence of Curly Dock, Smartweed and annual Morning Glory exists.
 - b. Insect Control:
 - Furadan 4F at 1/2 pint per acre. Harvest after 7 days. 1 pint, 14 days.
 - Supracide 2E at 2 pints per acre. Harvest after 10 days.
 - Imidan 50W at 2 pounds per acre. Harvest after 7 days.

TRANSPLANTING??

Use XL-640, a 16-32-16 starter, water soluble, and when added to the transplanting water reduces transplanting shock as well as promotes rapid root growth insuring good starts. Use on tobacco, tomatoes, strawberries, etc. Also excellent to use on seedling beds and in greenhouses.

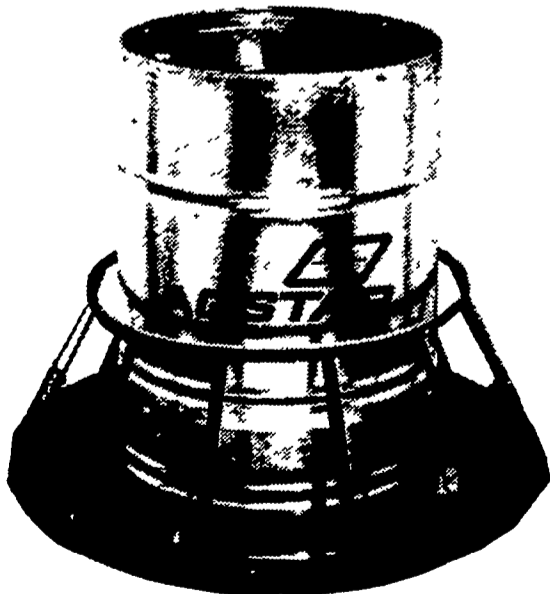
