

## Agway total calf rations TCR I and TCR II can bring her to breeding weight by 14 months

The Total Calf Ration Program was researched and developed at the Agway Farm Research Center, and supported by a field study on three dairy farms. A total of 288 animals were involved. Significant findings:

- Heifers reached breeding weight of 750 lbs. by 14 months of age
- They were nearly an inch taller than heifers grown on a conventional program

TCR I is for heifers from birth through five months, and TCR II for six through nine months. It is a pelleted, complete, self-fed ration containing all the protein, energy, minerals, and vita-
