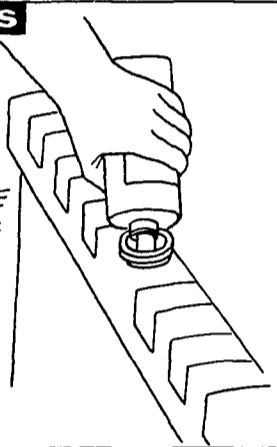

#### COOLING SYSTEM

IF YOU NOTICE SLUDGE ON THE INSIDE OF THE FILLER NECK, FLUSH THE SYSTEM WITH A CAN OF FAST-FLUSH. FOLLOW DIRECTIONS THEN REPLACE ANTIFREEZE AND WATER MIXTURE. CHECK FOR LEAKS.
