

An aerial view of Ca-Lill Farm's manure storage area shows the wood construction and reinforcements. It was essentially home-made and has a life expectancy of 40 years. Measuring 48 feet square, and 10 feet high, it will hold manure for seven months before hauling will have to begin. A roof may yet be added by the Beilers — a feature which is recommended by specialists in the Extension Service.

The storage area is built out of treated lumber and is rated to hold seven months worth of manure from his 50cow herd. He's using a skid loader and conventional spreader with tailgate to haul the manure onto his 150acre farm.
