



2 eggs, beaten Cream shortening and sugar, add eggs and beat. Add sour milk and vanula.

Then, sift flour, cocoa, and salt, and add to mixture. Put soda in hot water - add last. Chill and drop on cookie sheets. Bake at 400F. Makes 45 cookies.


