- 1. They Had A 1 Week Peak Of **85.32%** Hen Day Production.
- 2. In 10 Months From 22½ Weeks Of Age They Have Produced 232.5 Eggs Per Hen Housed. They Are Projected To Hit 271 Eggs Per Hen Housed in 12 Months Of Lay (Eggs Sold).
- 3. They were a very persistent group, staying over 84% production for 23 consecutive weeks and over 80% production for 29 consecutive weeks.
- 4. The Average Feed Conversion For This 10 Month Period (Winter Months) Was Under **3.6 Lbs.** Of Feed Per Dozen Eggs Sold.
- 5. The Monthly Average Depletion Was Only **0.61%**Per Month.
- 6. After 10 Months Of Lay The Eggs Produced By This Flock Are Grading Out At 95.3% GRADE A LARGE.
