FREEZING FOOD IN QUANTITY

The cubic foot capacity of your freezer is the starting point for figuring out the amount you can freeze at one time. Put in no more than two or three pounds of warm food per cubic foot of freezer space. For example, a 15-cubic foot freezer should not have more than 45 pounds of unfrozen food added in a day. A lesser amount is better.

Freeze food soon after it is packed. Keep packages in the refrigerator until several are ready to be put in the freezer. Each time the freezer door is opened much of the cold air escapes. For faster freezing, place packages against freezer plate or coils.

Rectangular or square-shaped containers are usually preferred for freezing because they stack easily and fit compactly side-by-side.

Use baskets, shelves, dividers, racks and other accessories to organize packages. The freezer will hold more if packages are arranged neatly.
