

Penn State horticulture show announced

UNIVERSITY PARK - This year's Homecoming Weekend at Penn State University in October will be minus one of its traditions - the Horticulture Show. The tradition must be broken since the setting for the show, the Ice Pavilion, will be used for skating at Homecoming time. Thus, the Horticulture Show will be held September 18 and 19 at the time of the Ohio State-Penn State football game.

The show attracts 15,000 to 20,000 visitors each year. In this Bicentennial year, the "Hort Show" will present a bit of a historical representation of horticulture as well as a current expression of horticulture today. This year's theme is, "A Bicentennial Salute to Horticultural Pennsylvania."

The "Hort Shows" of today have changed greatly from the first event, says Kathy

Bauer of Pittsburgh, show manager. The first show was held during Farmers' Week in January 1908, in the attic of the Agricultural Building. The featured exhibit was a nine year old York Imperial apple tree. Other exhibits were mostly plates of apples contributed by many commercial fruit growers in the Commonwealth.

Presently, "hort students" work toward an aesthetically appealing exhibit as well as

an informative one, manager Kathy Bauer pointed out. The students are responsible for all aspects of the Horticulture Show including promotion, management, and construction.

Four main areas of horticulture will be featured in this year's events - fruits, vegetables, floriculture, and environmental plants. The show will open with an introduction-dedication area

A sales area will be featured as well as a display by Phi Alpha Xi, national honorary fraternity for floriculture and ornamental horticulture.

This year's fruit division is under the direction of Gene Schramm of Pittsburgh. The exhibit will include a backyard fruit garden. Most of the fruit grown in Pennsylvania will be displayed. The exhibit will also contain a fruit processing section. The vegetable exhibit will

focus mainly on two areas - the home vegetable garden of 200 years ago and the vegetable garden of today. Heading up the exhibit will be Marilyn Jezik of Natrona Heights. Home canning, one of the most important uses of vegetables 200 years ago, will be depicted in an old-time kitchen setting. In the modern garden, terracing will feature various plots and new innovations in vegetable growing.

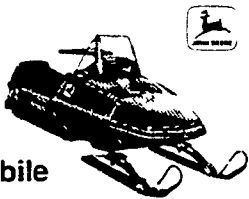
A sales division will offer a variety of fall harvest products and plants. The sales help cover costs of producing the Horticulture Show.

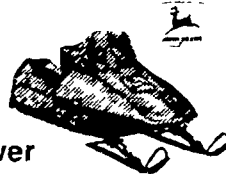




