# Solanco Fair begins Wednesday

QUARRYVILLE - Exhibitors will be moving into their display areas this coming Tuesday in preparation for the Solanco Fair, which gets underway on Wednesday. Although livestock judging is scheduled to take place Wednesday morning, the Fair isn't "officially open" until 7:30 p.m. that day.

## Vegetable data book available

WASHINGTON, D.C. - A new statistical bulletin summarizing U.S. fresh market vegetable statistics for 1949-75 has been released by the Economic Research Service (ERS) of the U.S. Department of Agriculture.

This report covers a wide range of production, price, foreign trade, and other use data, including per capita consumption, and serves as a basic reference for the fresh vegetable industry.

Data are shown individually for 16 leading fresh vegetables. These statistics supplement the Vegetable Situation, published quarterly by ERS. The new bulletin will be updated every few years.
