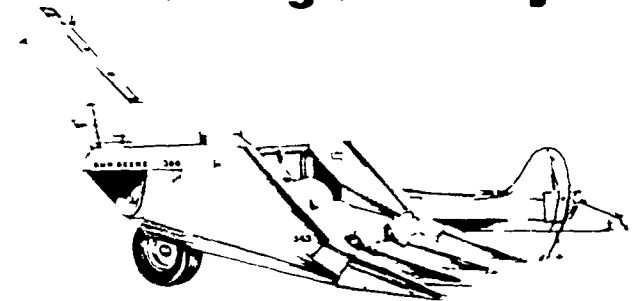

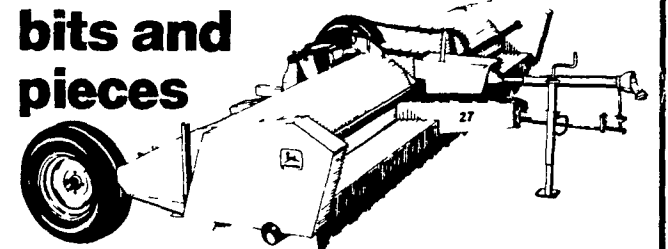

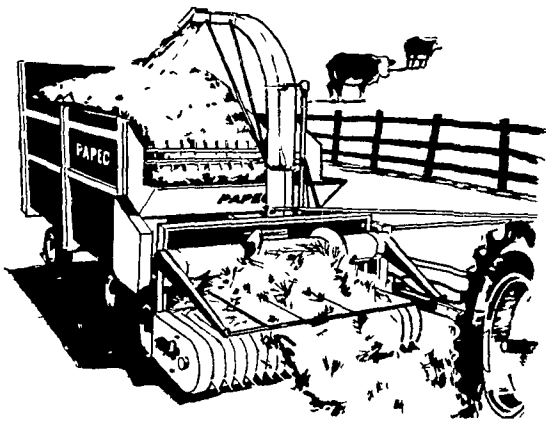

WASHINGTON, D.C. - The volume of U.S. seed exports during 1975-76 was up sharply, USDA reports. At 292.2 million pounds, that volume topped the 1974-75 total by 13½ per cent. Value of the exports, at \$124.5 million, was up 7½ per cent.
