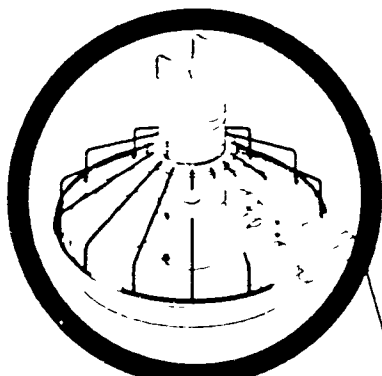

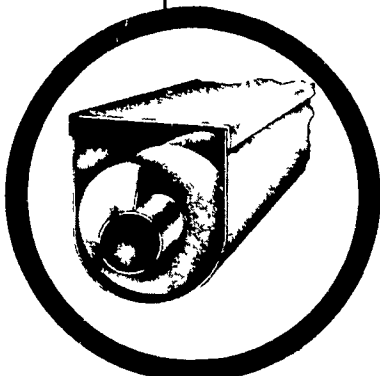
Electric anti-roost cable and insulators simply snap into place over the U-Trough cover.



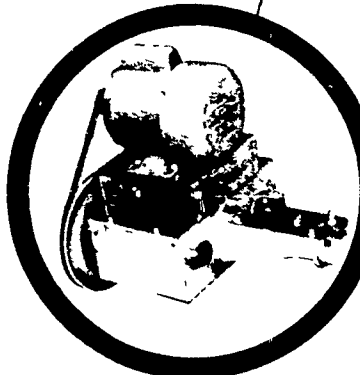
A photo electric eye in the control pan "senses" feed level. Automatically fills on demand.



Simple clamp hangers fasten at the top with "S" hooks for quick height adjustment. Use with either ceiling or winch suspension.

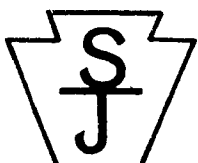


Core-type auger and U-Trough keep feed thoroughly mixed. Provides a uniform ration from beginning to end of the feed line.

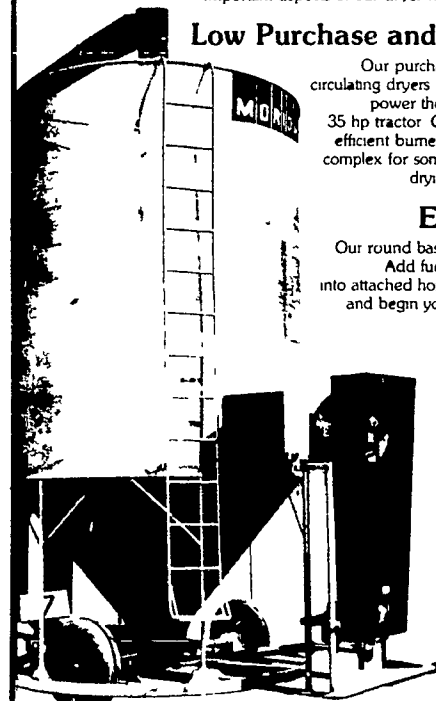
Ease of Operation
